Popcorn Fundraising Report – Gen Grosse:

Gen shared 8051 had the best popcorn sales in 8051 history, the Pack sold \$14,167.95 in person and the Troop sold \$32,624.22 in person, together they had a combined \$3,732 in sales online/shipped. Additional Trails End rewards earned were sent to the parent's email. Congratulations!

Treasurer's Report – Gen Grosse:

Gen provided an update about the Troop/Individual Scout account balances (popcorn earning are reflected in the Individual Scout accounts) and shared the Troop is expecting a \$159.00 Council reimbursement for Scout/Adult fees. Sue received confirmation from Kathy at Council that the check was mailed in December. Gen will check with Kimberly Meeks to see if it was received. (It was and has been deposited into the Troop account).

Gen has registered the Troop 8051 to participate in MATO for Peach Cobbler sales.

Outdoor/Camping Chair Report – Gen Grosse:

While Kris Anderson was unable to attend the meeting, Gen reported the Troop made the \$400 deposit for 12 Scouts and 3 Leaders to attend Summer Camp at Schoepe Scout Reservation at Lost Valley (North San Diego County for the week of Jul 3-9, 2022).

The first payment to be made for Summer Camp of \$100 per Scout due on February 1st (\$1,200). Second payment of \$2,400 is due April 16th, final payment of \$2,885 is due May 17th. (This is for 12 Scouts and 3 adults). The Troop will need a final head count soon.

Mr. Padilla will conduct the Troop's upcoming Fishing Merit Badge campout scheduled for February 18-20th
